### HealthCenter21 used for curriculum delivery & remediation across multiple programs!

Lancaster County Career and Technology Center uses HealthCenter21 across a number of its health career programs. "The program was **introduced to our entire health center** to enrich the curriculum," says Nina Eckert, instructor for the Dental Assisting program at LCCTC. She describes how HealthCenter21 adds another dimension to the current curriculum delivery. "**Each instructor can decide on the number of units** she will use for her program. For instance, Dental Assisting kicked off the year with the Job Seeking Skills unit to provide a foundation for the students resume and cover letter assignment. The Nursing Assistant Program required all students to complete the Infection Control Unit to emphasize the importance of asepsis."

Lancaster County CTC originally used HealthCenter21 as a remediation tool. "The program was introduced in the Health Center as a **means to supplement instruction for students not eligible for clinical rotation**," says Eckert. "For our health programs, clinical rotation is a 'real-life' experience in an actual doctor's office or health facility where the students use competencies learned in the classroom."

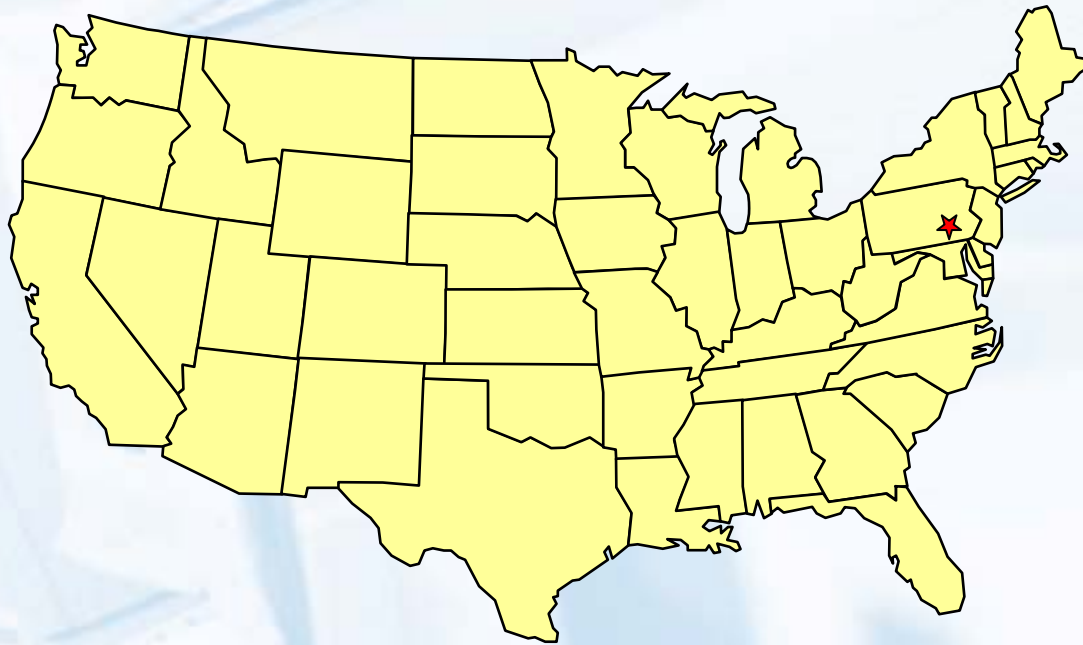
